This position will require you to carry out detailed data collection on the shop floor, analyse and reach factual conclusions that will help shape future procurement and processing strategy.

As plastics gain increased media coverage, scrutiny is being placed on unrecyclable plastics which will lead to significant packaging design changes. The result is a larger volume of recyclable plastic which with greater public and industry awareness will result in favourable business conditions, particularly for our production site in the UK.

Job Summary

To best support us, our ideal candidate will have the ability to work with people in all levels of the business from the production floor to management. Detail driven and analytical, you will demonstrate absolute ownership over your essential responsibilities to achieve the required outcomes.

Whilst driving cost analysis is a vital part of the role, we seek a candidate who can also demonstrate creativity in problem solving and ultimately help to drive margins up. When faced with challenges you will need to be patient, yet tenacious and persistent.

You will need an open mind-set, and work flexibly with innovative ideas, yet be practical in delivery. Problem solving dialogue provide opportunities to build and enjoy the interaction with colleagues. As a strong performer you will be; an excellent communicator, impatient to use your initiative and be both investigative and imaginative, able to thrive on change and pro-active to drive change.

With no fear of failure, you will appreciate being performance measured and use this information to hone your future working methods. We expect adherence to our processes and procedures, be able to take direction and to complete administrative work with good grace and competence.

Therefore, this role is suited to an ambitious individual who is excited to help drive the development of the factory as a whole.

Role Requirements:

To be considered for this role, candidates will be interested in manufacturing, happy to walk the shop floor and not afraid to get their hands dirty as often as is needed. They will have an inquisitive mind that wants to find out what drives the numbers, thrives on change and is willing to identify and drive change. Motivated to learn and develop their knowledge, this isn't a role for a desk bound "number cruncher", but someone who wants to make an impact on the ground and grow with the business.

Essential Duties & Responsibilities

Business Development & Delivery:

- > Meticulously log and collate data whether it is readily available or requires collection personally on the production floor
- > Control and maintain stock sheets, ensuring absolute accuracy to drive high quality financial reporting on a weekly basis

- > Implementation and maintenance of a standard budgeting system for new and existing contracts and commodities ensuring these are accurate and consistent
- > Finance point of contact for commercial teams for budgeting of proposals and contracts. Ensuring overall accuracy, adherence to standard models and required margins
- > Contribute to the production of financial information for monthly forecasting, budget and performance for the factory
- > Produce meaningful and accurate analysis of factory performance for budget comparisons and to ultimately drive better decision making
- > Monthly WIP and inventory valuation and reconciliation ensuring that any variances are investigated, resolved and reported on in a timely manner
- > Log and perform deep analysis of man hours, product movements, stock days, downtime, wastage, production times, downtime and throughputs to refine costings.
 - > To compile performance information for all commodities and contracts
 - > To work with management to refine operating standards
- > Be proactive and entrepreneurial in identifying the most valuable product lines and notify management to adjust procurement or sales strategies accordingly
- > Ensure any budget changes are communicated effectively and justifiably to appropriate stakeholders
- > Regularly review product and customer profitability margins and costs to serve and set meaningful margin / contribution KPI's and report to management
- > Ensure appropriate controls are in place for all factory procurement and in line with company policy
- > Utilise knowledge and experience to identify day to day control issues and identify control implications resulting from changing circumstances and enlist the support of team members to resolve
- > Drive cost and profit opportunity awareness with all team members
- > Be flexible in approach, able to adapt to change and support adhoc reporting requirements
- > Support with implementation of ERP system and contribute to ongoing enhancement of capabilities
- > Work with operations and business development teams to investigate unexpected results or adverse trends, and communicate outcomes to management to drive prioritisation and resolution
- > Work with management to translate financial measures into practical operational targets and establish control processes to ensure achievement of these targets

- > Experience of taking responsibility for month end reporting of Work in Progress and Stock reporting
